General Daily Schedule, Groups and Schedules

All members will be broken into groups upon registration and remain in those groups for the summer. Your child's age and grade will be put into consideration along with numbers registered. Rotation schedules for your child's group will be available a week in advance.

It is the responsibility of the parent to locate your child's group using their rotation schedule if you need to drop off after 9 am or pick up before 4:30 pm. Rotation schedules will be available at the front desk as early as the week before the session begins. Throughout their daily rotations, members will move throughout areas at Riverview Elementary. Please pick up our monthly calendar for some highlighted activities. Check at the front desk for daily announcements and reminders.

Online Registration

Summer Registration is now online! You may choose to pay in full or to pay your balance in either 3 or 6 automated installments. Those members who are on financial assistance will need to sign-up in person as we are not able to utilize scholarship amounts in the online system.

In Person Registration

You may also choose to register for the summer program in person, but you will be required to pay 50% of the cost upon sign up and members will not be able to attend any session if total fees are not paid in full before the first day of the session. Sessions do fill up and we accept a limited number of members. In-Person Registration can be taken care of at the Boys & Girls Club front desk between 9 am and 5 pm.

Refunds/Transfers

We staff based on registration. There will be **NO REFUNDS OR TRANSFERS ON ANY FEES PAID FOR ANY REASON**. If a member cannot attend or is prohibited for attending for any reason, NO refund will be given. **Fees are NOT transferrable from one day to another or one child to another.**

Financial Assistance

Limited financial assistance is available for those who qualify. A financial assistance application must be filled out **in full** for each child. A copy of the most recent pay stub from each income earner in the household must be turned in with the application(s) and/or proof of any income in the household. **Financial assistance DOES NOT include field trips or membership fees.** Please allow at least a week to process your application (so apply early). Those with financial assistance will unfortunately not be able to utilize the online registration system.

Half-Day Fridays and AfterCamps

June 16th, June 30th, July 14th, July 28th, August 11th

Running a fun, safe summer program that your child will love is our number one priority. In order to make sure our summer staff receives the time and resources necessary to provide quality programming, the Club will close at 1 pm every other Friday. A separate Friday AfterCamp program will be available for a limited number of campers from 1-5:30 pm on these days. Sign up online or at the front desk.

Lunch/Snacks

Please remember to send your child with healthy snacks and a healthy non-perishable sack lunch. Please mark your child's lunch box. Refrigerators and microwaves are not available for storing or heating member's lunches. Please also make sure your child has all needed utensils to eat their food.

Personal Toys/Electronics

We ask for our members to leave all electronics, toys, trading cards, etc. at home unless requested to bring for a special activity. All personal belongings are the responsibility of the Club member and cannot be held by staff. Check our lost & found each day to claim left behind items.

Backpacks/Jackets/Lunchboxes

Because of the number of kids who participate in our summer programs, we ask our members to bring limited things to the Club. A lunchbox and water bottle are all that is necessary. Lunchboxes will be placed in a separate bin upon arrival. The Club offers sunscreen and has access to water fountains. If your child is bringing anything that does not fit in a lunchbox, please send it in a small knapsack and avoid large backpacks. If your child's group moves throughout the day, they are responsible for carrying all of their belongings. Please check the monthly calendar for additional items needed for special outings.
