The Main Ave Club facility is closed to individuals other than Club staff and Club members. Parents/Guardians may pick up their Club members at the Club's front door.

The Boys & Girls Club of La Plata County provides a safe, structured environment with fun activities designed to boost academic performance, reduce risky behaviors, and promote healthy lifestyle choices.





The Club provides materials, games, and equipment; therefore, Club members are discouraged from bringing personal items/toys to the Club.

If misplaced or broken, personal items/toys will not be replaced by the Club.

### Field Trips

- Offsite travel includes walking or transportation provided by the Club.
- Some off-site activities are provided at no charge, while other activities include a modest fee. Incidental purchases (snacks, souvenirs) are the responsibility of Club members. Club staff is not permitted to hold money for Club members.



## For the safety and well-being of all Club members and staff:

- The Club follows local, State, and Federal public health guidelines. The Club does not have a nurse on site.
- Club staff are mandatory reporters. Staff is required, by law, to report any suspicions of abuse or neglect to the Department of Human Services.
- Any Club member who is sick, may not attend the Club. Parents/guardians will be called if their child/teen becomes ill while at the Club. The child/teen must be picked up as soon as possible.
- Club staff are trained in CPR/First Aid and are AED certified.
- In the event of a life-threatening emergency, warranting medical attention, Club staff will call 911. Parents/guardians will be notified.
- If there are individuals who are NOT ALLOWED to pick up your child/teen, the Club must be provided with written documentation. It is imperative that any changes in status or family situation be communicated to the in a timely manner. info@bgclaplata.org

Parents/guardians are required to provide current contact information (cell phone/email) for themselves as well as the individuals listed in case of an emergency." 970/375-0010 ext 1 info@bgclaplata.org

Parents/Guardians will receive email ALERT Notifications from the Club in case of urgent operation changes

## Discipline Guidelines

- Providing a safe environment (both physical and emotional) is a Club priority. The Club's guidance, and as required, restorative discipline model is progressive, based on the severity of the incident. The Club focuses on prevention, taking advantage of teachable opportunities through restorative protocols.
- Any Club member who behaves in a way deemed by staff to be disruptive, and /or physically or emotionally dangerous, or who abuses privileges (including the use of Club technology) will be disciplined appropriately.
  - Club privileges can be revoked. Any persons who are deemed in violation of the Club's Code of Conduct will be subject to removal from the Club facility.
  - Parents/Guardians who display behaviors or clear indicators that they may be impaired or in crisis, will not be allowed to pick up their child/teen. Club staff will calmly work with the parent/guardian to find an alternative transportation option. If the parent/guardian becomes combative or insists on taking their child/teen, Club staff are required to call 911.
